Every year I stand amazed at God's faithfulness, goodness, and perfect timing.

It's been a year of transition as we moved into our building debt-free in June 2021. *Growing Together* was our theme this year, and we have grown in many ways as an organization. One



way we grew together was we began the school year serving 6,690 students and are now serving 8,301 students, an additional 1,611 students in ten months.

With rapid growth and a new building, it is no surprise that we ran into a few challenges. Jim Meyer, who has been with Hand2Hand as a volunteer since we began, continues to bless us with wisdom and leadership. He previously was the CEO of a large grocery chain and understands food distribution. I smile to think of how God brought Jim to our board years ago - He knew we needed his insight and counsel. Along with the committed, passionate, and 'can do it' attitude of our fantastic staff and church partners, we learned, adapted well, and finished the school year stronger than ever.

Every year I stand amazed at your compassion, kindness, faithfulness, and generosity.

Recently I was talking to one of our donors. He likes to build and sell things and donate his labor income to Hand2Hand, and he hand delivers his donation every time. The other day he came in with a gift but told us that it was his insurance refund this time. After I thanked him and told him his generosity is inspiring, he replied, "I just need to take care of my kids." Hearing the love in his voice as he called Hand2Hand students 'my kids' brought tears to my eyes. Since I have known him, he has also brought in two donated bags of Hand2Hand food each week to his church.

His generosity is inspiring, and so is yours.


As you look inside these pages, I pray you are blessed as you read about the **impact we are making together.**




FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS


